THESE PEOPLE DRAW NEAR TO ME WITH THEIR MOUTH, AND HONOR ME WITH THEIR LIPS, BUT THEIR HEART IS FAR FROM ME. AND IN VAIN THEY WORSHIP ME, TEACHING AS DOCTRINES THE COMMANDMENTS OF MEN.

The Jews Were Very Religious
 Had zeal For God
 Dedicated / Devoted
 Worshipped regularly

- God's chosen people - **Rom. 9:1-5**
- Most of the Jews were lost because they sought salvation on their own terms rather than God's - **Matt. 15:7-9**

All This, But NOT Saved

Religious, but NOT Saved

God is Spirit, and those who worship Him must worship in spirit and truth.

- We are NOT saved just because we are religious — **Gen 4:3; Lk. 18:9-14; Mat 7:21-23**
- Our religion MUST be according to the truth — **Col. 3:17; Jn 4:24**

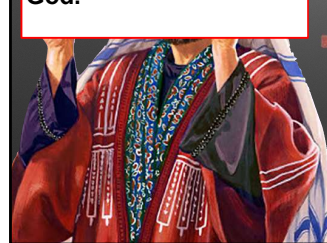
All This, But NOT Saved

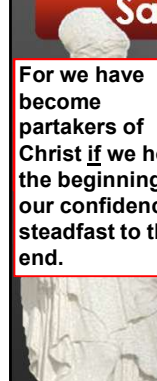
Saved, But NOT Saved
