- >To turn up the nose at
- **≻**Deride, Jeer
- If one has the idea that he can mock God he is deceived.

Gal. 6:7

"for whatsoever a man sows, that shall he also reap"

- > Proves God cannot be mocked
- Seed brings forth after its kind
- ➤Gen. 1:12 "after his kind"

Gal. 6:8

"for he that sows to his flesh shall of the flesh reap corruption"

- > Flesh = do the works of the flesh
 - Gal. 5:16-21
 - Rom. 8:13
- **▶** Corruption = loss of salvation

Gal. 6:8

"but he that sows to the Spirit shall of the Spirit reap life everlasting"

- >Spirit = to be led by the Spirit
 - Christian Obedient
- Life Everlasting = contrast to corruption

Gal. 6:9

"And let us not be weary in well doing: for in due season we shall reap, if we faint not"

- ➤ Don't reap harvest next day
- ➤Weary = discouraged
- ➤ Faint = give up, quit, relax

Gal. 6:10

"As we have therefore opportunity, let us do good to all men, especially to them who are of the household of faith."

- **▶**Do good to All men
- >Especially Christians
- ➤ Opportunity carries obligation

- 1) As true as the law of Gravity
- 2) Guarantees existence of Heaven and Hell

4) We reap more than we sow

"But this I say: He who sows sparingly will also reap sparingly, and he who sows bountifully will also reap bountifully." 2 Cor. 9:6
